Scholarship: Funding will be provided for qualified applicants of members' immediate family and students including Akron Public Schools. Contributions have been increased to other organizations such as NAACP, Urban League and First Tee of Greater Akron. Junior Golf Club members will receive automatic scholarships as our appreciation of their commitment to our organization. Must participate at least 3 years in the Junior Gold Club.
